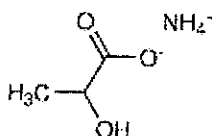

Ammonium lactate is a humectant applied as a **cream** or lotion containing 12% lactic acid neutralised with ammonium hydroxide. It is used in the treatment of **dry** scaly conditions of the skin including ichthyosis.
